WHY LAKE GENEVA?

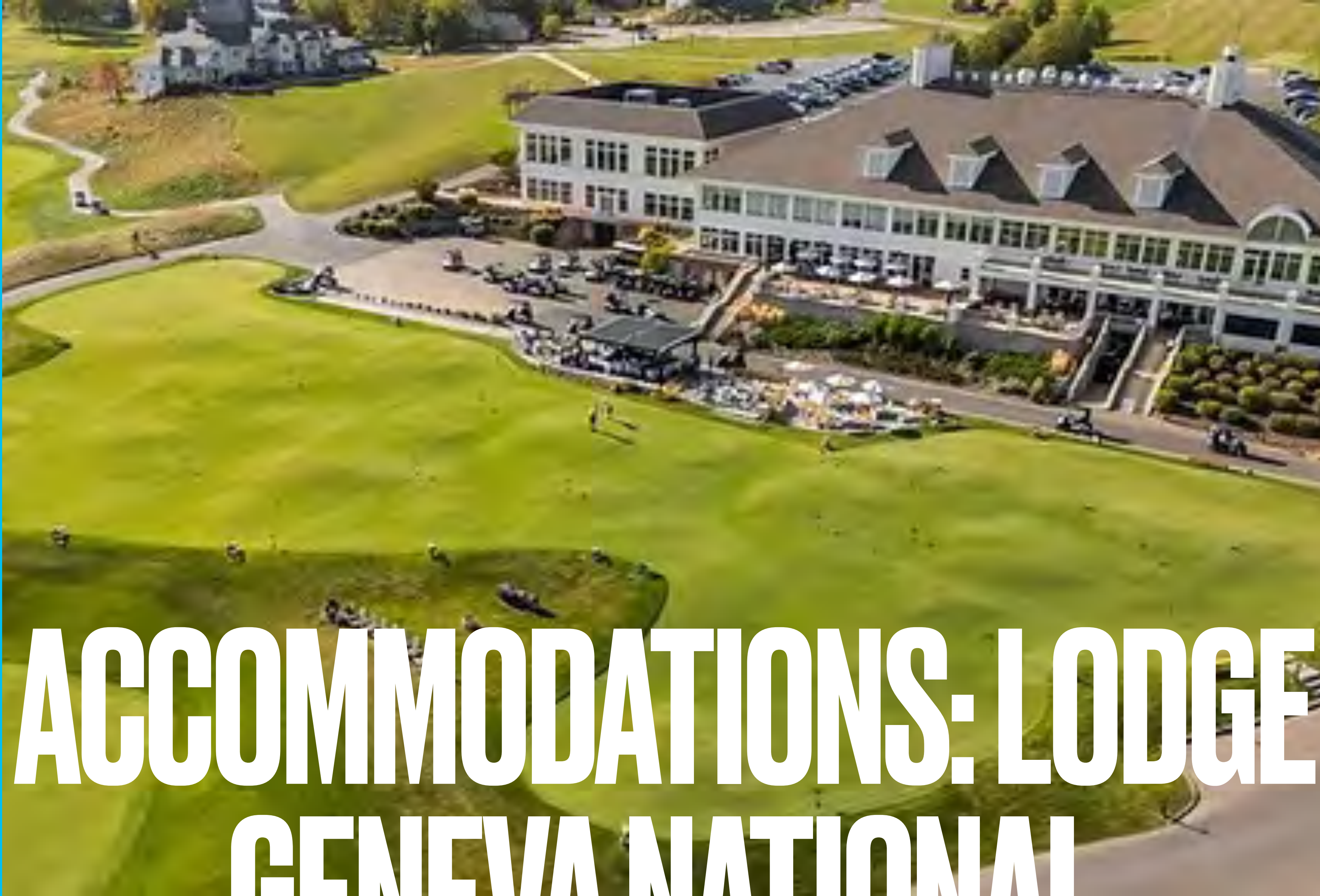
- Located within 1 hour of 2 major cities: Milwaukee, WI. and Chicago, IL.

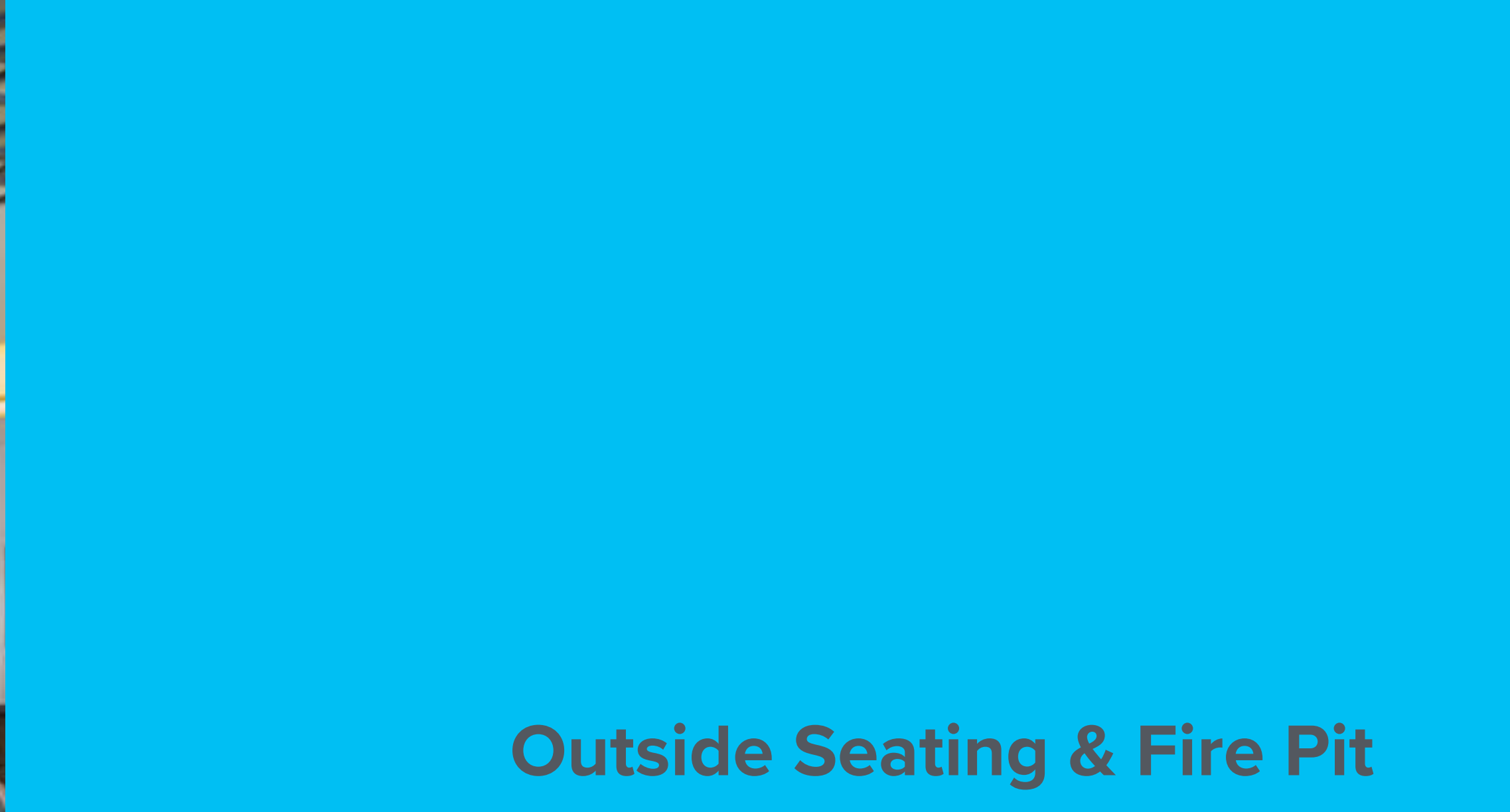

LODGING DETAILS

- Complimentary on-site parking (Not typical for the area)
- Complimentary WiFi
- Dogs allowed inside hotel for \$50 per dog as a one-time fee
- October 1-6, 2025 Rates: \$144 per guestroom, plus tax, per night
- Tax Rate: 11.5% Tax
- Option to add cash breakfast buffet each morning - Additional fees per guest



JUDGE'S DINNER

- To be held inside the property's Aspen Ballroom
- Additional fees to utilize the space, and food + beverage minimums required
- Dinner + Dancing with a \$60-\$80 cover charge per guest
- Cash bar on site





BITEWORK FIELD

SHOW GROUNDS

- Enter from the back of the hotel with stairs leading down to the show grounds
- Both the show and bite work fields are on hotel property
- Picnic tables and snow globes to be removed from the area to allow appropriate set up



IN SUMMARY...WHY LAKE GENEVA?

- All activities to be held on or within hotel grounds - eliminating any additional travel!
- All participants under one roof! Additional opportunities for fall bon fires, dinners, socializing, etc.
