Louisburg, KS, is the symbol of American values and hometown feelings located in the heartlands with an old time feel to the town and people, though close enough to a major metropolitan that all modern day conveniences, restaurants, shopping ect.. are only a skip away (25 minutes). Local Timber Creek Event Center can accommodate over 500 people for draw night or numerous wineries in the area that also hold large events plus a brewery all within 15 minutes of stadium area.

Louisburg is a city in [Miami County, Kansas](#), United States and is part of the [Kansas City metropolitan area](#).^[5] As of the [2010 census](#), the city population was 4,315.^[6]

The closest international airport is Kansas City (MCI) located 62 miles away or 58 minutes

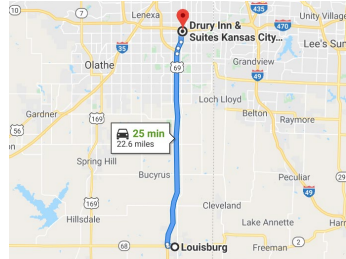

Proposed site for USCA WORKING DOGS COMPETITION & FH CHAMPIONSHIP is the youth soccer complex or flag football field (more conducive for the WDC due to privacy)– multi sport area,

Lewis-Young Park is a 200+ acre expansive parkland with soccer, baseball, softball and flag football fields with wooded trails, shelters, BBQ grills, a fishing lake, playground, restrooms and open field areas that can accommodate the smallest or largest of events.

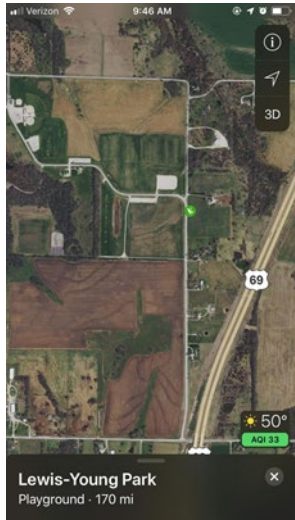
The park has primitive trails although some are more easily defined than others

The park is also home to the spectacular Powell Observatory that is operated with national acclaim by the Astronomical Society of Kansas City. The main entrance of the park is located at 26600 Jingo Road, one mile north of 271st Street

Tracking will be approx. 15 minutes away (town of Paola) from soccer complex fescue approx 6-8 long sod managed farm 310 acres for WDC (same fields at Mid Central 2019 Regionals)

FH Championship will be Brome Hay 125 acres, approximately 20-25 minutes away from Stadium

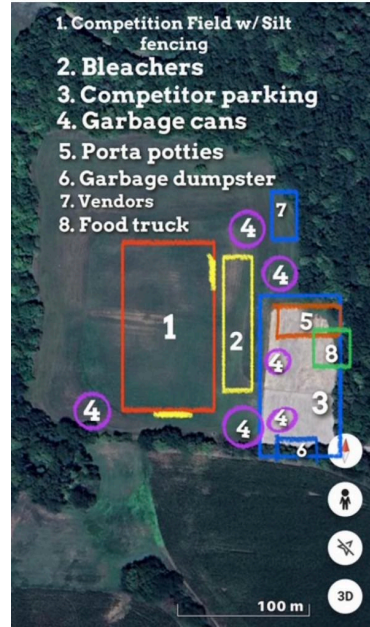
